

## Teaching for Equity Pilot Program: Nomination Form Questions

**Once you begin filling out this application you will not be able to save and return to your partially completed content. Therefore we recommend you use this document to view the full list of questions in advance, prepare your materials and responses, and then enter them into the Nomination Form.**

**ABOUT THE PROGRAM:** The Teaching for Equity program is a pilot initiative that will provide financial support to yoga teachers who are teaching for little or no pay in historically marginalized communities. Twenty-five teachers will receive stipends to offer ten yoga sessions at no cost to participants. (Teaching may be done in person or online, depending on local pandemic conditions and safety precautions.)

**WHO CAN APPLY:** This pilot program is open to yoga teachers who meet the following requirements:

- A minimum of 2 years of experience teaching yoga within a historically marginalized community
- Actively or recently teaching (during the past 9 months) in a historically marginalized community, for little or no pay
- In financial need (defined as having an annual income below US\$30,000 for applicants from [high-income countries, or adjusted local equivalent](#))

The program is open to YA members and non-members, with no geographic limitations. The program is also open to candidates who have previously received funding, grants, or scholarships from Yoga Alliance, the Yoga Alliance Foundation, and/or Ivy Child International.

Selection priority will be for teachers who are personally more economically vulnerable, come from the communities where they teach, and have a history of teaching in said communities.

### HOW TO APPLY:

- Yoga teachers can either be nominated or can self-nominate for a competitive selection process.
  - Each teacher applying can receive only one nomination.
  - This nomination form is available **online only**.
- Gather the following information that you will need for the nomination process:
  - Teacher profile (you can provide this with a resume, biography, website, social media pages, etc.)
  - Documentation of your work as a yoga teacher (you can provide a sample schedule showing when/where you are teaching or have taught, an email from a studio or group where you are teaching, or a website or social media post listing you as a teacher)
  - A description of the community\* where you will be teaching
- Review the questions in this form and prepare your responses to submit in the nomination form.

**\*The community where you will be teaching must be historically marginalized.** This means that they may have been excluded in places where yoga is taught, or they may have faced barriers that have made it hard for them to take yoga classes. Below is a list of examples of historically marginalized communities. You can also propose teaching in other communities that are not on this list:

- LGBTQIA+
- BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, People of Color)
- Differently-abled
- Economically marginalized / communities with high poverty
- Other communities whose yoga classes were stopped or significantly disrupted due to the pandemic (e.g., high poverty, correctional institutions, schools in under-resourced areas, communities with geographic / economic / technological barriers to access)

**OTHER KEY INFORMATION:**

- Yoga classes supported through this program must be offered for no cost. The stipend is provided to replace the payment that the yoga teacher would normally receive for their teaching, and it is for teachers who have continued to offer classes free of charge in communities that are currently unable to pay for yoga instruction.
- Priority will be given to teachers who come from or are members of the communities where they teach.

**SELECTION PROCESS AND STIPEND PAYMENT:**

We intend to process applications as quickly as possible. Depending on the volume of applications, it could take multiple weeks to process the stipend disbursement.

Stipends will range from US\$300-US\$900 to compensate for ten yoga class sessions. (Payment rate varies by country and is based on [national cost of living index](#)). Payment will only be issued to the approved nominees.

“I (nominee/nominator) certify that all information is valid and complete to the best of my knowledge and hereby authorize Ivy Child International to verify any of the below information as deemed necessary. I certify that I have reviewed the Teaching for Equity Eligibility Requirements and Selection Criteria, and I understand that the nominee may be required to provide subsequent documentation if shortlisted.”
